As you will know, if you have been able to be in church the last couple of Sundays, the PCC decided at its Day Away to go ahead with the building project that we have been considering for the last couple of years. This will be formally launched in November this year but the first phase of the project, for which we already have planning permission, will be done this summer.

We would love to have the opportunity to bring you up to date with our thinking so far and get as much input as we can for the development of the project. Though most of the fundraising will be done after the official launch in November we do need to raise funds this summer for phase one. To this end you are warmly invited to one of two evenings that we will be holding in June:

**Wednesday 15 June in the Centre
Tuesday 28 June in the Vicarage Garden**

Both will begin at 7.30pm with a light meal followed by a presentation, opportunity for questions and time for prayer. If you would like to be involved in this first stage of what we feel on the PCC will be a very exciting project over the next two or three years, then please plan to come to one of these two evenings. By November we will have much more detailed plans of what we hope to do but the priorities for phase one are already very clear and we would love to share them with you.

For catering purposes it would be useful to have an indication of numbers, so it would be helpful if you could let us know if you are planning to come to one or other of these evenings by replying to this email. However if plans change at the last minute and you find yourself available to come, please come anyway. We will cater for some last minute extras.
