Charlotte Skinner is going to be holding a cake sale today after the 9.30am service and after the 6.00pm service to raise money for a project she is going to be involved in over the summer.

Charlotte writes...

This summer I will be working with a Christian project called Latin Link in Recife, Brazil. I will be joining a team of six other students from around the UK and together the team will help support four weeks of summer camps organised by an NGO called Compassion and supported by a number of local churches, as a way of reaching out to the poor. The camps are mostly made up of 11-16 year olds who come from some of the poorest areas of Recife. The idea is to give the young people an action-packed week with lots of fun, learning activities, sports, swimming and clear devotional times where Christ is presented as Saviour. I will be involved with running the camps, helping teach English, running sports and activities, helping share God's word and participating in many waterfights! The money I raise will go towards materials for those children in Recife allowing them to have basic things like pens, books and card games that so many of us take for granted.
